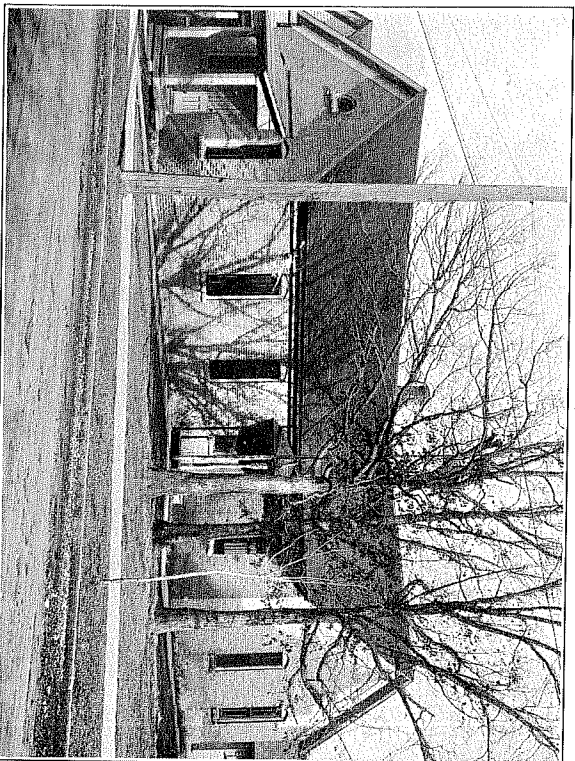


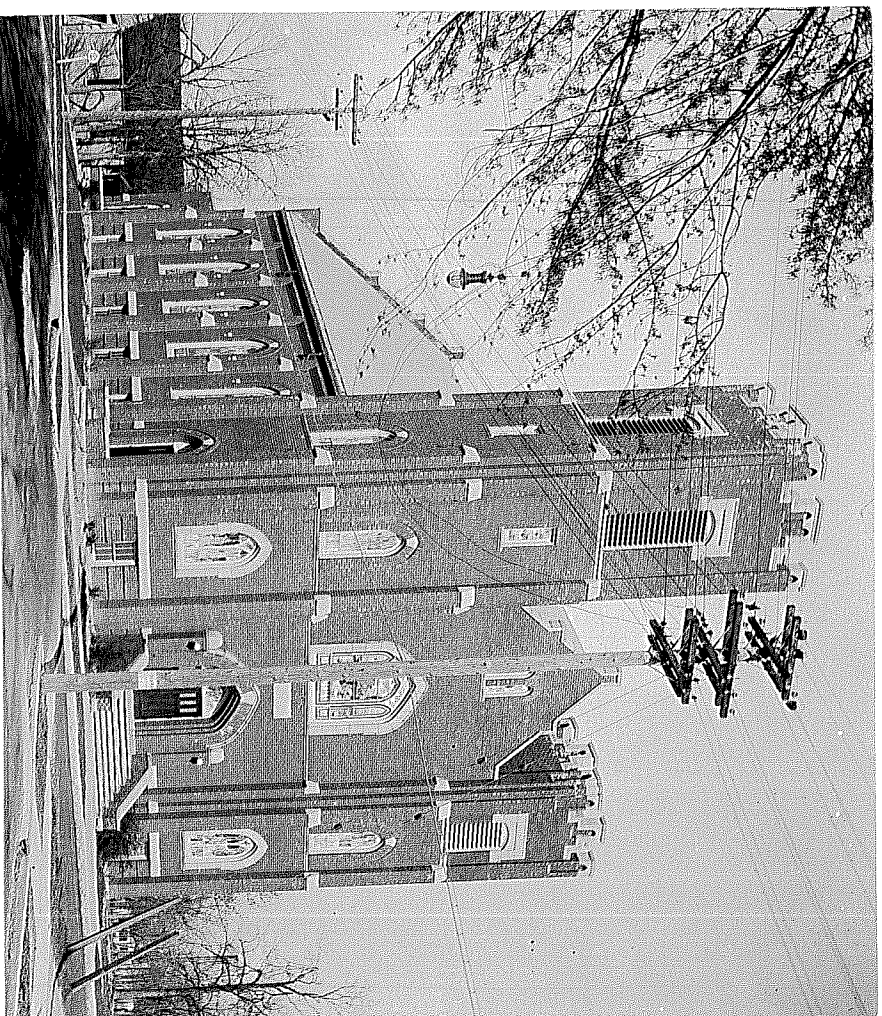
Pastor W. Hinneenthal.

On April 19, 1885, Pastor W. Hinneenthal of Franklin, Milwaukee Co., Wis., was called to be the first resident pastor. He accepted the call and was installed June 14, 1885, by the Rev. C. Popp, Wrightstown. During the thirty-two years of his faithful labors the small flock which he found here on his arrival developed into a goodly congregation.

Convinced of the great importance of a Christian parish school for the future internal and external growth of the congregation, Pastor Hinneenthal succeeded in inducing the congregation to make provisions for the Christian education of the youth. His offer to assume the duties of a teacher was met by a resolution of the congregation in July, 1885, to build a school house. Subscriptions amounting to about \$700.00 made the immediate erection of a school house on a lot behind the church possible.
